The Guadalupe Regional Medical Foundation Board of Directors has announced the launch of its three-year "Giving. For Life." Capital Campaign. The campaign officially began January 1, 2009, and has set a goal of raising \$2.3 million to participate in the \$100 million expansion of the Medical Center currently under way.

Achieving this goal will require the time, talent and treasure of many of our community's citizens and GRMC's own employees. Gifts to the Capital Campaign will be used to help GRMC in countless ways, including:

- Recruiting and retaining excellent nurses and staff
- Expanding programs and services, such as chemotherapy and wound care
- Purchasing state-of-the-art technology
- Adding preventative and wellness care programs
- Providing a private and comfortable environment for healing

Demographics clearly demonstrate a growing demand for comprehensive healthcare in our region, particularly for the increasing number of elderly citizens and aging baby boomers. We have set big goals for the Capital Campaign because we have an opportunity to make a huge impact on people's lives. Based on current numbers alone, without taking into account projected population growth, over the next ten years GRMC is likely to see at least:

- 7,500 babies born
- 50,000 people admitted for care
- 300,000 patients admitted for emergency care
- 30,000 people undergo surgery
- 600,000 patients undergo diagnostic imaging

Guadalupe Regional Medical Center is currently expanding and renovating its facilities to create an ultramodern healthcare complex. This transformation will provide our region and area physicians the first-class medical center we need to accomplish the hospital's Mission—to be the preferred provider of excellent and comprehensive healthcare. As our Vision Statement affirms, "we aspire to be an elite medical center, providing healthcare that is both technologically advanced and compassionate." It is the goal of the Guadalupe Regional Medical Foundation to help GRMC achieve its Vision.

Our Plans.

Our expansion will double our size to 260,000 square foot. The Emergency Room will triple in size. A three-story Inpatient Tower will house completely new Maternity and Medical floors, as well as facilities for a future inpatient unit. And it will all be complemented by new technologies, expanded services and a contemporary new look.

The result will be a first-rate facility for the seven-county region served by the Medical Center. The three-year project, slated to conclude mid-2010, will encompass 141,000 square feet of new construction, 65,000 square feet of major remodeling, and significant technological upgrades. The new facility will have 117 beds, three floors, and the capability to expand to 154 beds and seven floors should future needs require it. All new patient rooms will be private.

Why Your Gift is Important.

The Medical Center's expansion qualified for financing through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and is insured through the Federal Housing Administration (FHA). GRMC is a not-for-profit community hospital jointly owned by the City of Seguin and Guadalupe County. Unlike most community hospitals, which receive a portion of their operating revenues from local taxpayers through a hospital district tax rate, GRMC is funded primarily through patient revenues and charitable contributions.
