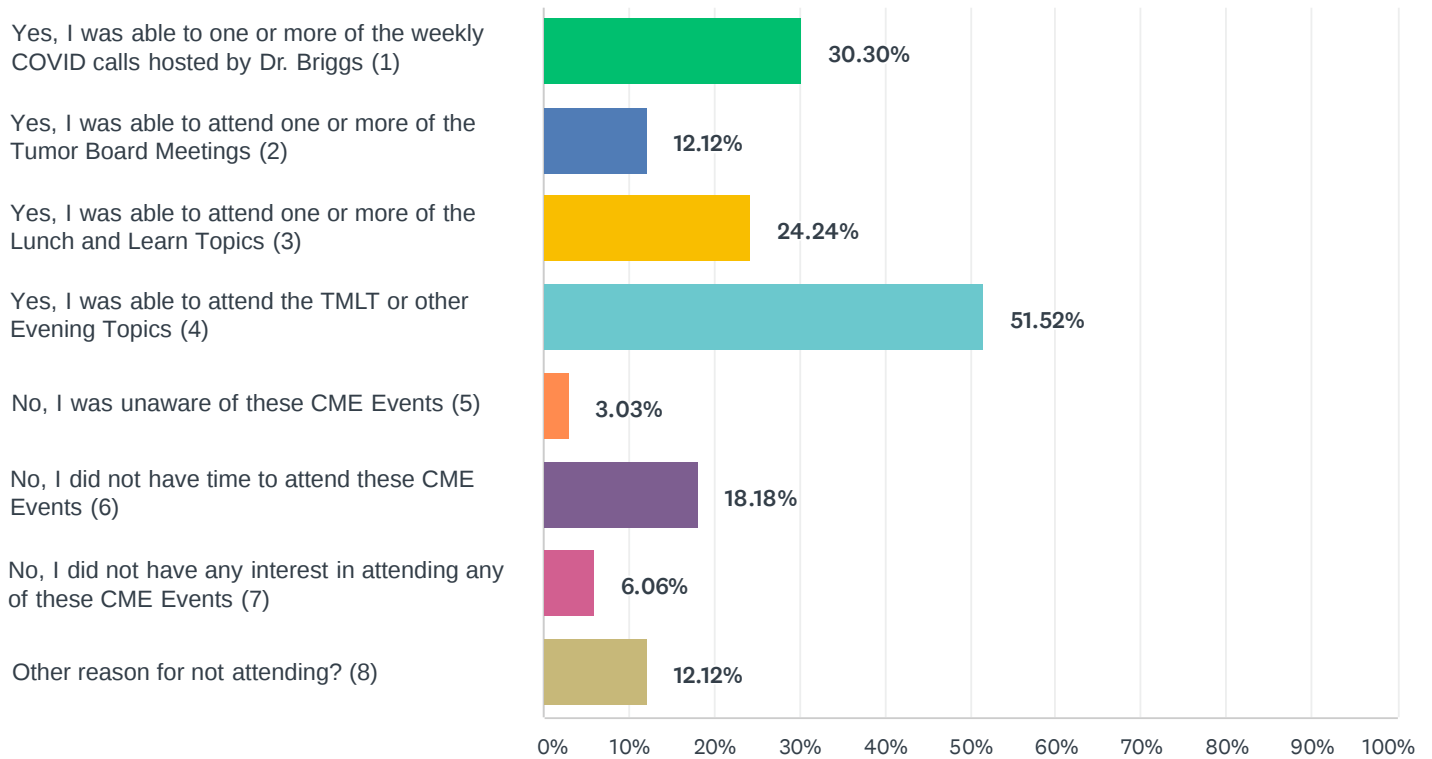


Q1 During 2021, were you able to attend any of the GRMC/GHN CME Events? If yes, which ones. If no, check reasons listed. (check all that apply)

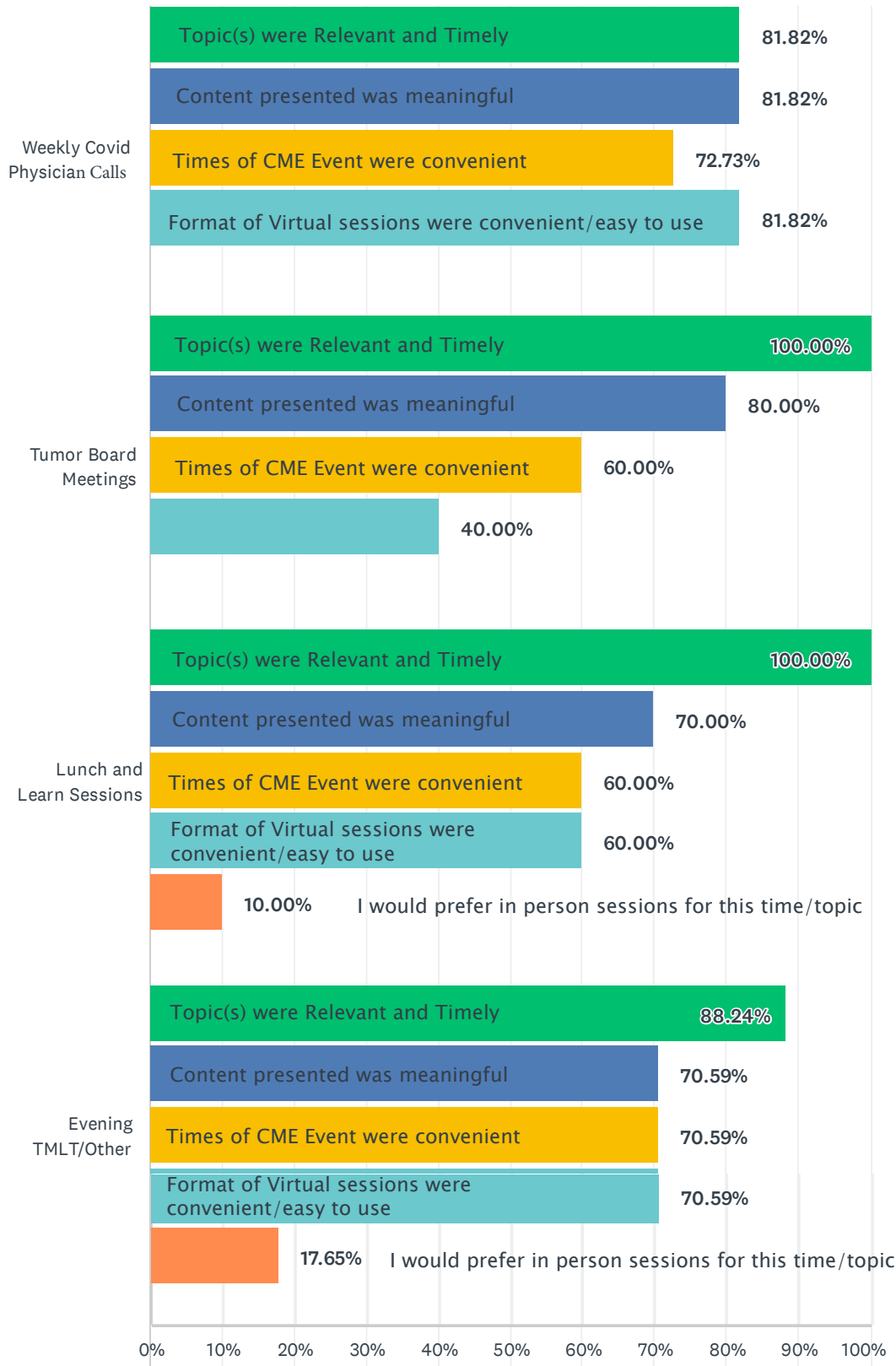

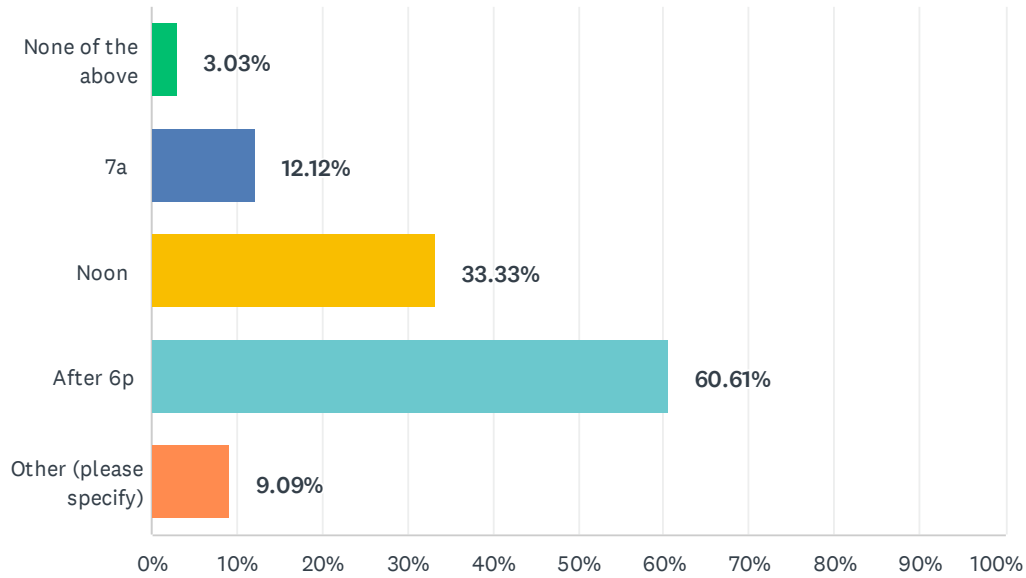

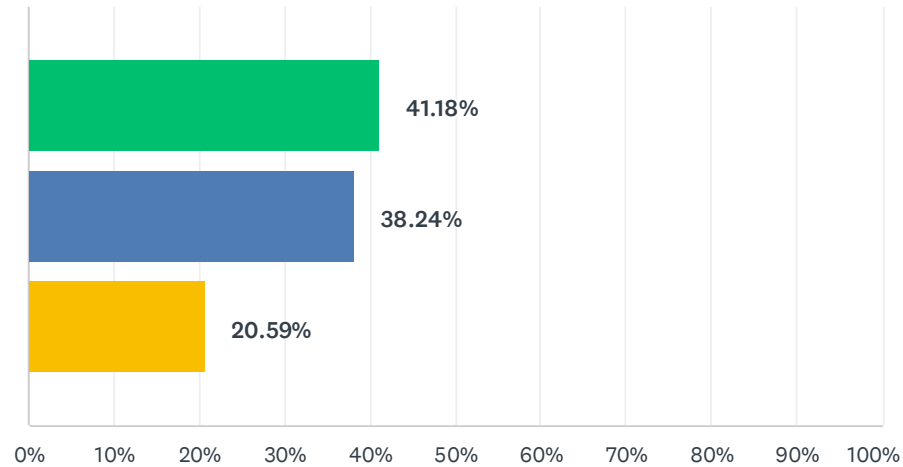
